NEXT STOP 2012 - LONDON GATEWAY BOROUGHS

In February 2006 the Thames Gateway London Partnership in association with the East London Gateway Boroughs of Barking & Dagenham, Bexley, Havering, Lewisham and Redbridge commissioned Continuum to research and produce an Olympic 'offer' document for the sub-region. Building on our extensive work across the Thames Gateway.

The prospectus, entitled 'Next Stop 2012', promotes the Gateway Boroughs' enviable location as the nearest neighbours to the main London 2012 Games venues, and outlines the sub-region's collective offer through its numerous physical, economic and cultural strengths.

COMMUNITY SPORT NETWORKS CAPACITY AND POLICY DEVELOPMENT - SPORT ENGLAND

Continuum have recently been working with Sport England's Community Investment Team and their East Region in the development of Community Sports Networks - a key component of Sport England's vision to create a single and coherent 'system' for the delivery of community sport.

All Community Sports Networks have the common aim of increasing participation in sport and widening access and opportunity for all to participate in sport and physical activity.

Continuum produced a Policy Guidance Note for the funding of Community Sports Networks through Sport England's Community Investment Fund working closely with Investment Teams in Sport England's regional offices to develop a policy which could be applied nationwide.

In the East region, Continuum also supported 11 emerging Community Sports Networks by providing a range of services to assist local authorities and other key partners in the development of these integral local delivery agents for sport.

We have advised Sport England's regional office and the Eastern County Sports Partnerships on the continued evolution of these Networks across the region and the overall development of a Single System for Community Sport.
